NOTICE OF ABANDONMENT OF APPEAL

Pursuant to California Rules of Court, rule 8.316, appellant hereby abandons the appeal filed on October 26, 2021 as the issues raised in the appeal are now moot. On January 20, 2022, during the pendency of this appeal, the Board of Parole Hearings (Board) found Rene Enriquez suitable for parole. (Exh. 1–Inmate Board Actions.) Thereafter, the Governor referred Enriquez's parole grant for review by the full Board. (*Ibid.*) On July 18, 2022, the Board voted to affirm the panel's January 20, 2022 decision to grant Rene Enriquez parole. (Exh. 2—En Banc Decisions at p. 7.) Accordingly, Enriquez will be released from prison.¹
